- Survey Notes:**
- The first recorded survey in the Wolfback Ridge, 2 OS 137 by Frank Aiken, in 1948, created a framework onto which later surveys depended, including the two large surveys: 3 OS 62, and a follow up survey in 1980 by the BLM entitled "Survey, Boundary of Golden Gate National Recreation Area, T. 1 S., R. 6 W., Mount Diablo Meridian, California". William Lockett told me that he and his partner Sherm Hool, worked for Aiken on the 1948 survey, and a few years later worked on Wolfback Ridge in a series of first surveys on the hill. Those Hool and Lockett surveys, and monuments shown on them and found by us, are the basis of the boundary position of this survey.
 - Two recent surveys to the west, one by L. A. Stevens & Associates, Inc. filed in 2015 RS 130, and the second survey by Steven Jacobs, and not yet recorded, appear to be based on the Aiken survey, and on points found by 3 OS 62 from the Aiken survey, and agree with the occupations lines shown on the unrecorded survey by J. C. Oglesby Job No. 15537 in 1957. There is missing information on the 2015 RS 130 survey, and there are no explaining notes on that map telling us what evidence was used to place the boundary lines on the ground. L. Stevens described his work over a phone conversation, but there are still some unexplained questions on that survey, the resolution of which is beyond the scope of my survey.
 - The 2.5" BLM monuments set by the 1980 survey replaced 1.5" monuments set by the Survey by Robert Baker, LS 2825, filed in 3 OS 62. Although it is my belief that they were both following the boundary of Frank Aiken, Jr. the measurements between those points are inconsistent. And to the southeast there is about a four foot difference between these monuments and the historical surveys of the area (see "BLM Note").
 - The surveys by David Contreras (M19-M22) are based on local monuments found by Lockett (M10) in Cloudiview Trail, and that system of surveys touches my easterly boundary line. There are surveys by Lockett (M2, M11, M12), based on the monuments in Cloudiview Trail, and it is my opinion that those surveys are based on a different, and separate, control system, and I do not accept them for the position of my easterly corners.


